- 1 Corinthians 1:10

Each Tuesday and Thursday morning during Lent, Caleb or I are offering a time of devotion and prayer. We are using the book of 1 Corinthians as a basis for these online devotionals. When Paul begins his letter to the Corinthian church, the first concern that he has for them is that they are not living in the unity that God desires. Instead of finding connection in their love for God, they have found division by focusing on their beliefs and their teachers.

Tonight, during our Wednesday Connection Bible study, we will be focusing on The Lord's Prayer. We will look at the phrase, "Our Father, who art in Heaven, hallowed be thy name." Whenever we worship, we begin the service with this unison prayer. When we join together to pray the prayer that Jesus taught us, we seek to find that unity that God desires for us. We find that unity by praying together, and by being reminded that we are praying to OUR Father. While the world offers us numerous opportunities to separate, OUR Father offers us the opportunity to see past our divisions and to find unity in our love for Him and His love for us.






Ministries in the Church
