Every year since 1970, April 22<sup>nd</sup> has been set aside as Earth Day. It is a day that is set aside to celebrate the achievements of the environmental movement and to raise awareness of the need to protect Earth's natural resources for future generations. Every year we set aside one day to remember our responsibility to take care of the world in which we live.

Unfortunately, like so many other things, the idea of care for the world has become a political topic. Instead of focusing on God's call to protect the gift of the world that we have been given, we debate "global warming." Instead of talking about how we might better care for the earth that was created for our benefit, we debate the idea of "climate change."

We want to argue whether or not these topics are "man-made" or whether or not they are a hoax. However, what we cannot debate is that God calls us to take dominion over this world. That is not permission to do whatever we wish to God's creation. Instead, it is a call to protect this gift that was meant for us and for our children. Genesis 2 reminds us that, "The LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to till it and keep it."

We have only been given one earth. This world that we are given is not a political talking point. This world that we have been given is not a partisan debate. This beautiful world of ours is a gift from God that we are called to appreciate and protect.

### **New Members Sunday School Class**




