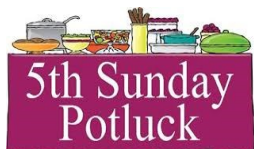




Sunday Worship Information

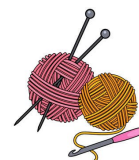
5th Sunday Worship & Lunch
