From Your Minister - Christian Smith

Let no evil talk come out of your mouths but only what is good for building up, as there is need, so that your words may give grace to those who hear. – Ephesians 4:29

As I write this message, we are in the middle of our Tuesday Assistance program. Each week we open the doors to the community, and we offer grocery store vouchers to those in need. For others, we help with their utility bills. Today we have a large crowd of people, and their conversation has turned to politics.

As I listen, there are people in the crowd on both sides of the aisle. They have begun to debate one another about what the condition of the country was under certain presidents and what their life was like under the various presidents. However, they are not sharing about how their life was "better" under any president. They are, instead, telling one another how their lives have been "worse" under other presidents. They are doing much of the same thing that we do and that politicians do. Instead of proclaiming the merits of their candidate of choice, they are sharing the faults of their candidate's opposition.

When we were young, many of us were taught, "If we can't say anything nice, don't say anything at all." Scripture shares that same lesson numerous times. However, too often, we feel that when it comes to politicians or other people with whom we disagree, we ought to be able to say whatever comes to our minds. As the people of God, we are called to remember that all people were created in the image of God. We are called to remember that when people hear us constantly speaking evil of others, then we appear to be people filled with distrust and hatred. Instead, let's seek to build one another up and offer grace to those with whom we disagree so that we can show that we are filled with God's love.
