From Your Minister - Christian Smith

Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?'

And I said, 'Here am I; send me!' — Isaiah 6:8

For those who may be unaware, the headquarters of the Cumberland Presbyterian denomination is just outside of Memphis. Tomorrow morning, I will be traveling there to spend the rest of the week. I have been elected to serve on the Ministry Council for the denomination and, throughout my term, I will travel to Memphis a couple of times per year.

The basic purpose of this council is best described on their website. "The Ministry Council is the denomination's ministry programming division. Together, the Ministry Council and its Ministry Teams create resources to assist individuals on their spiritual journey and congregations in their varied ministries." It is an honor to serve. It is also a huge responsibility. It is a responsibility I am not sure I feel worthy to fulfill.

Let's seek to help one another see the abilities that God has given each of us and the ways that we can each make a difference in the Kingdom of God.
