#### From Your Minister - Christian Smith

"When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you." - Isaiah 43:2

Yesterday, I had the honor of preaching for the Celebration of Life for Dick and Pat Brumfield. Before that service, I gathered with the family at the graveside for their burial. It seems that whenever I stand in that sacred space, the weather is always cold, wet, or both. As I said to the family yesterday, I think that makes a great theological point.

As we walk through life, we face storms. Whether it is grief, struggle, uncertainty, fear, or any number of problems that come our way, some things simply make life seem dark and dreary. But the clouds do not last forever. The sun will rise again. But when we face those difficult moments, we may wonder, how do I keep going?

The good news is that we do not walk through those difficult moments alone. God does not wait for the skies to clear before walking with us. God meets us in the middle of the storm and gives us the confidence to say, "Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me."

As we continue our Lenten journey and life's journey of faith, let us remember that God is with us, guiding us, strengthening us, and carrying us forward. The storms may come, but they will not last forever. And so, when we wonder how to keep going, the answer is not in our strength, but in trusting the One who walks beside us, leading us forward step by step.
