From Your Minister - Christian Smith

"'This', he said, 'is what you have heard from me; for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."— Acts 1:4-5



Last week was so busy. It was filled with activities, worship services, and responsibilities. By the end of the week, I am always worn out, and I need the resurrection and promise of renewal that comes with Easter morning. Our service on Sunday was filled with Easter joy and celebration. It also included the reminder that resurrection is not the end of the story. Instead, it's the beginning of something new. The week we turn the page from "Discovering Our Next Steps" and we begin a new series, "Walking with the Spirit: A Pentecost Journey." Let's all strive to do so with hearts open to where God is leading next.

This Sunday, we begin with Acts 1:1-5, and we remember that following his resurrection and appearances to the disciples, he tells them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait. He promised them that a gift from God was on its way. They just had to be patient.

The disciples have just experienced the unimaginable. Jesus had risen from the dead, but instead of rushing forward in triumph, they are told to pause and wait for what comes next. It reminds us that the Christian journey is not about sprinting toward Heaven, but walking with God in trust.

As we begin this Pentecost journey together, we are invited to listen for God's instruction and to wait upon God's promised gifts. As we journey through this season, we will strive to remember that we are not just remembering the story of Pentecost, we are still living it. As we journey forward, may we have the courage to wait, the faith to trust, and the hope to believe that God's promises, like the Spirit, always arrive right on time.


