"And when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left, your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, 'This is the way; walk in it." – Isaiah 30:21

During the season of Lent, we spent time listening for God's call as we explored what it means to *Discover Our Next Steps*. Together, we were reminded that faith is a journey and that we are called to keep putting one foot in front of the other as we seek to serve God.

Men's Bible Study




