Over the past few months, through Lent and the season Easter, we have walked a path together seeking to discover where the Spirit is leading us next. We've talked often about walking with the Spirit and listening for God's call. We have prayed, reflected, and asked what our next step might be.

The hard truth that we sometimes need to hear is that listening is not the same as moving. Faith is not only what we feel in our hearts or understand in our minds. It is what we live out with our hands and feet.

A week ago, we had an opportunity to live out that faith by packing food boxes for families in need through Food to the Rescue. As a church, we had a chance to serve our neighbors. Unfortunately, it was also one of our smallest turnouts we have had in all the years we have been doing this ministry. I know many are busy. I know life is full. But the needs in our community and our church haven't grown smaller.

In our church, we need Sunday School teachers to shape young hearts. We need liturgists to lift up God's Word in worship. We need volunteers to make VBS a place where children feel the love of Christ. We have existing service ministries and new ones that will begin soon. We need people. We need you to take the next step, not just in thought, but in action.

The Spirit is still leading. And while worship and prayer are vital, so is picking up a box of food, reading a story to a child, leading a prayer, or simply showing up to be the one who helps someone else take their next step.

Let's not settle for being a church that only talks about service. Let's be a church that shows up in service.


Sunday Worship Information

Twisted Stitchers


