I am excited to officially announce that we are preparing for a very special Sunday in the life of our congregation. On June 29<sup>th</sup>, we will have a special guest preacher joining us from Colombia, South America. The Rev. Jhony Montaño serves as the senior pastor of the "Jesucristo es la Solución" Cumberland Presbyterian Church in Popayán, Cauca, Colombia. Rev. Montaño is also a candidate for Moderator

at the upcoming Cumberland Presbyterian General Assembly, which gathers next week in Knoxville.

In 2025, the Cumberland Presbyterian denomination is marking 100 years of mission work in Colombia. That is a century of partnership, evangelism, education, and faithful witness to the Gospel in South America. Rev. Montaño's presence with us is a reminder that we are part of a global body of believers. This is more than just a Sunday with a guest preacher, this is a moment to celebrate our shared calling, our deep connection, and our shared history as Cumberland Presbyterians and children of God


