From Your Minister - Christian Smith

"Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility regard others as better than yourselves." — Philippians 2:3

This week, our denomination gathered in Knoxville, Tennessee for the General Assembly of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church. This annual meeting is a time of prayer, worship, discernment, and decision-making for our denomination. At the opening business session on Monday morning, one of the most significant acts that takes place each year is the election of our new moderator. As the highest elected role in our denomination, it is a great honor to be elected.

Among this year's nominees was Rev. Jhony Montaño from Colombia, South America. As we celebrate 100 years of mission and ministry in Colombia, his nomination is a powerful testament to the global service, partnership, and growth of the Cumberland Presbyterian denomination.

But what happened next showed the example of true faith. Another nominee, Rev. Daniel Barkley, stood to make his nomination speech and, moved by love, humility, and a desire to seek unity in the church, he chose to withdraw his name from consideration. He urged the body to support Rev. Montaño and, in his actions, he offered not just words, but a witness to the grace that should define the Church at its best.

Rev. Barkley's decision to give up the spotlight was not just a kind gesture. It was a powerful example of who Christ calls us to be and what Christ calls us to do. Rev. Barkley could have sought recognition, but he chose to lift up someone else. We do not see that kind of humility and grace every day, even in the church. But it is exactly who we are called to be, and it is a powerful example of who the church and the world need us to be.


