From Your Minister - Christian Smith

"Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility regard others as better than yourselves." — Philippians 2:3

This past Sunday, we gave thanks for 158 years of ministry together. We remembered the past and we looked forward with hope to what God has in store for us, while committing ourselves to be a praying church as we press on toward what lies ahead.

Part of what gives me such confidence for the future is what I witnessed during my recent sabbatical. While I was away, you continued to worship, to care for one another, and to those around you. Your faithfulness reminded us all that the strength of this congregation is not found in one person's leadership, but in the Spirit working through all of us together.

This coming Sunday, we'll take a small, but meaningful, step as we remember our commitment to prayer and drawing closer to God's will. We will worship outside. As we leave the sanctuary, we will be reminded that the church is not defined by a building. Instead, the church is the people of God, who gather in Christ's name and allow themselves to be empowered by the Spirit and sent into the world.

Worship is never meant to stay within four walls. On Sunday mornings, we lift our voices in song and prayer. But throughout the week, we worship God by the way we live. Every act of kindness, every moment of mercy, every word of truth, and every prayer spoken is an act of worship.

As we prepare for this week's outdoor service, I invite you to think about where God is calling you to worship with your life. What does it look like for you to be the church not only on Sunday, but on Monday through Saturday as well?

How is God calling you to press on in prayer? Let's be ready to worship, not just with our words, but with our lives.


