#### From Your Minister - Christian Smith

"Little children, let us love, not in word or speech, but in truth and action."
- I John 3:18

Over the last several days, I have had some conversations that have reminded me how much our congregation cares about our church's ministry to the community and each other. A few people have come to share concerns and suggestions about how we can make the ministry of our church family stronger. They did not come to complain. They came to help find solutions.

As I have reflected on those conversations, I have realized that sometimes it can feel like we are just going through the motions and doing what needs to be done to keep things running. At times, it is hard to take the extra steps that may be necessary to share the Good News in meaningful ways. But it is often those extra steps that help someone truly see the way of salvation or hear God's call.

We are careful not to make anyone stumble, and that is good. But God calls us to do more than simply avoid harm. We are called to look for ways to guide, encourage, and love people toward Christ and toward the love that Christ offers.

Prayer is a vital act of love. When we pray for others, we show compassion. But prayer can also move us to action. It can guide us and help us find ways to give hands and feet to our love. Prayer helps us move from simply not hurting to helping. It helps us move from avoiding what is wrong to doing what is right.

My hope for all of us this week is that our prayers will lead us toward love. I hope our prayers will move us one step closer to being the church God is shaping us to be. We do not have to do everything at once. But together, through prayer, we can keep growing in faith and keep letting love lead our way.


